

#### **TOBUZ App**

We, Aadarsh, Ilesh, Aleena, and Aiyana, students of the 11th grade computer science stream, have built a bus logging and management application called Tobuz. After joining the computer science group, we wanted to utilise and develop our skill set by building an app, and we chose this idea as we wanted to build something relevant to our school. The app currently aids in the manual logging of bus arrival and departure times. Each bus has a QR code, which when scanned using the app, immediately logs the current time. This data is stored on the cloud, allowing transport managers to remotely monitor buses entering and leaving. Since this data is in a digital format, it is easy to process it for producing reports and analysing the performance of the transportation system. We, plan on adding many new features and improvements to the app in the future. Some of the features we have thought of, include full automation using mounted cameras, location and speed tracking on all buses, detailed bus routes with bus stops and timing information, and equipment (bus) and staff (driver and conductor) information. 

This is the first story to feature Sherlock Holmes, an amateur detective, and Dr Watson, Holmes assistant. In this story, we follow the adventures of the duo, as they solve a murder, gathering clues, ranging from bloodstains to cigarette ash, and footprints to wedding rings, as they eventually arrive at the most surprising of conclusions. This story was also the first to feature the use of magnifying glass as a detective tool. All in all, this book is sure to enthrall you and keep you on the edge of your seat.

"The story of Dr. Jonas Salk From Polio's Foe to Medical Marvel: Unveiling the journey of Dr. Jonas, Pioneer of Hope and Healer of Nations"

Dr. Jonas Salk was an American virologist and medical researcher. He was one of the pioneers who developed the first successful —Polio Vaccine in 1955. Way back in 1900, polio epidemics began to appear in the United States and Europe and started to spread all over the world. Around 16,000 cases of polio occurred in a year. Thousands and thousands of little children were affected with paralysis and many even died. The children who survived faced lifelong consequences with deformed legs, not able to walk on their own but have to rely on calipers and wheelchairs. Wanting to save these children from this dreadful disease. scientist Jonas Salk spent months and years in his laboratory and researched for a solution. He then invented the first

successful polio vaccine. He was such a great person that he first tested the vaccine on himself and his family members before giving it to the affected children. Hurray! The vaccine worked. This was a massively successful invention, wherein many innocent children's lives were saved. He was considered as a savior by the public at those times.

By 1959, Dr. Salk's vaccine had reached more than 90 countries. Within 25 years, polio was eliminated in the United States and in other countries who took the vaccine. Today, the children are hail and healthy and also safe from this deadly disease, mainly because of the remarkable contribution of Dr. Jonas Edward Salk. His dedication to vaccine development and disease prevention has left a lasting impact on the field of medicine.

A talk and a dialogue with KG, Primary and Middle School -The Study International, Puducherry.

and encouraging further creative expression

among our students in future events.

Today we had our first interactive session on Lifestyle enrichment and how Yoga can be a useful tool to achieve this goal. We introduced children to the idea that anything one does in absolute union of the self with the divine is - Yoga. Most often we see that good habits are

not very attractive or presented poorly whereas almost all bad habits are very attractive and made to appear cool. To break this misconception, we first asked children about their idea of good-health and what are some means to be healthy. Unanimously, all the kids had three top priorities – Healthy food, adequate sleep and sufficient body movements. Then we asked them - that inspite of having the knowledge, why most of us fail to do what's necessary and the answer was basically lack of motivation, badly organized lifestyle and the belief that healthy food is not tasty, basically good-habits are not cool and hence, not sustainable. We then introduced a short breathing meditation & body stillness and tried to observe the peaceful effect of this one-minute intervention. Children had a smile on their faces, they were more receptive and most importantly, they became aware of their breathing which automatically ensures better and deeper breathing, hence, enhanced concentration with the sense of true peace within. When told about deep-sleep and its healing effects, they became motivated to go tobed on early. Now comes food.... If we need to sleep early, say at 9pm....we need to eat atleast 2-3 hours before sleeping for the food to get digested to allow sound sleep. Hence, Dinner must be light and between 6-7pm. The kids got motivated to have a dialogue at home to request their parents for early dinner and to also offer help for the same. And finally, adequate movement.... Children were introduced, verbally, to the systems in Yogic practices and how they induce peace in the mind and enrich lifestyle. A popular and well-known practice like Suryanamaskara which is considered a complete package, if done in the right manner, consistently, along with some Pranayamas (Yogic Breathing) and relaxation techniques, one is sure to be healthy, both physically and mentally. Children participated actively in the dialogues

and came up with honest issues which sometimes makes these practices difficult to adopt on a regular basis and we collectively came up with ideas and alternatives to remain motivated and to get more and more people to switch to healthier lifestyle. In our upcoming meets, we shall touch upon emotional and spiritual health and the means to achieve them. None of these things are brand new to people, we simply reminded the kids to find the answer within instead of looking for a solution outside and it worked wonderfully.
